

Initial Steps to Ordering Dual Enrollment Textbooks

It can take up to 3 weeks to fill Dual Enrollment materials requests. Orders should be submitted no later than fifteen (15) working days prior to the start of the semester at HCC. If the form is not electronically submitted in a timely manner, there may be a delay in obtaining needed materials prior to the course start date and this could inhibit students from completing course work in a timely manner.

Once students have registered for their HCC courses, they will need to follow the steps below to order materials for their classes.

1. Students New to Dual Enrollment Textbook Ordering:

Return to your high school guidance office and request access to the Dual Enrollment Online Textbook Ordering System. The guidance office will provide you with a “Student Dual Enrollment Confirmation” print out. You will need this print out to complete the initial “Registration” process for your account. Follow the steps on the “Student Directions for Dual Enrollment Online Textbook Ordering” sheet to register your account, research and order required materials. The student directions sheet is attached or can be obtained from the guidance office or by emailing [“dualenroll@sdhc.k12.fl.us”](mailto:dualenroll@sdhc.k12.fl.us) and requesting a digital copy.

2. Students Returning to Dual Enrollment Textbook Ordering:

Contact your High School Guidance office and request your already established account be “Reactivated”. Once reactivated, the student will login with the student number attached to the account and the password the student created when he/she first registered in the system. Once the account has been reactivated, follow the steps on the “Student Directions for Dual Enrollment Online Textbook Ordering” sheet for researching and ordering required materials. The student directions sheet can be obtained from the guidance office or by emailing [“dualenroll@sdhc.k12.fl.us”](mailto:dualenroll@sdhc.k12.fl.us) and requesting a digital copy.

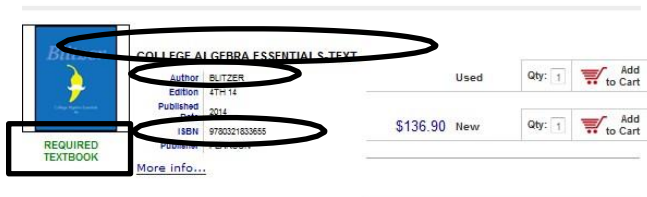
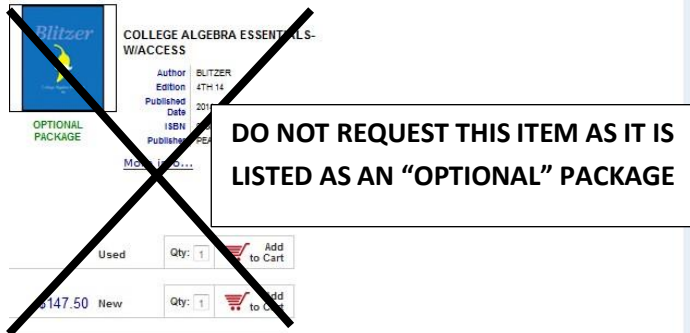

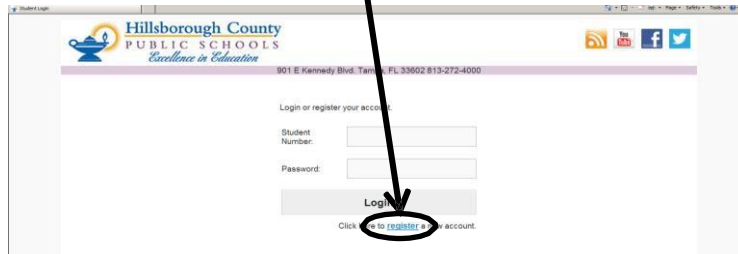
Information on books you need to order can be obtained by following the steps for visiting the online bookstore (<http://bookstore.hccfl.edu>) for each campus you are attending and search using the Course Abbreviation (ie... ENC), the Course Number (ie...1101) and the five digit Course Section Number (ie...14366).

REMEMBER: Different course sections and campus' may require different books. You must locate the information for the specific course and section you are registered for.

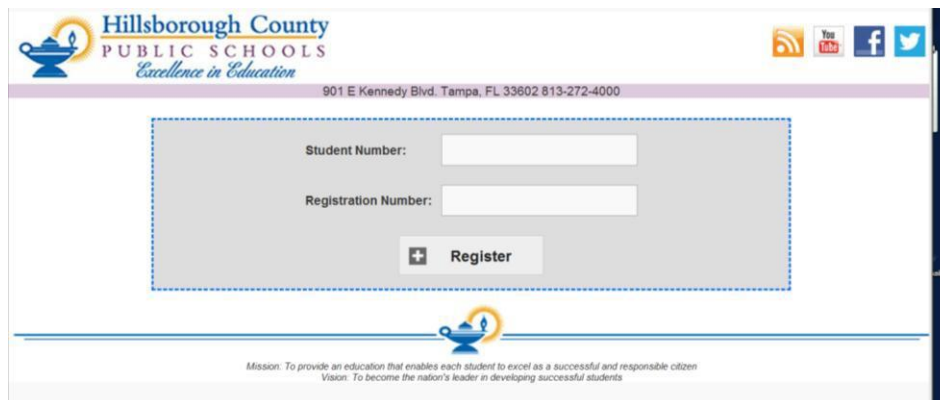
Students are only to request "**REQUIRED**" textbooks/materials. Do not request textbooks/materials listed as "**OPTIONAL**" by the course instructor.

1. Go to the following website: <https://www3.sdhc.k12.fl.us/dualenroll/student/>
The first time you access the site you will need to follow the steps "To Create a New Account" and complete the registration process. If you have already created an account, follow the steps "To Access an Existing Account".
 - a. **To Create a New Account:** Click on the "**Register**" link below the "**Login**" button. **Follow steps 2- 6 below.**
 - b. **To Access an Existing Account:** Enter your Hillsborough County Public School student number and self-determined password you created when you initially created your account. **Skip steps 2-3 and follow steps 4 through 6 below.**

Note: Each new semester, students must return to their High School Guidance Office site contact to "Reactivate" their account.



2. Enter your Hillsborough County Public School "**Student Number**" and the "**Registration Number (UID)**" located on the "**Dual Enrollment Confirmation Page**" printed by the Guidance Office at your school. Select "**Register**" button.
